EPGP Placements 2020-21

Overview

The placement process for the EPGP class of 2020-21 was conducted in spite of the interruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak and the subsequent national lockdown. The class comprised 73 students from diverse backgrounds, with an average pre-MBA work experience of 7.2 years. At the end of August 2021, 56 students had received and accepted campus offers, 13 off campus offers, 2 were on Sabbatical and 2 couldn't find suitable roles.




