Summary:

Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) invites applications for the position of Academic Associate for the Strategy Area from qualified candidates.

The position is suitable for research students and professionals with good academic credentials and a long-term interest in teaching and research in Strategic Management. The primary responsibility of an Academic Associate (AA) is to provide teaching and research support to the faculty in the Strategy Area. Candidates who have worked as AAs at IIMB in the past have gone on to join competitive doctoral programs of reputed business schools in India and abroad. Those who joined AA position with a PhD have gone on to become faculty of other educational institutions.

<u>Qualifications:</u> Candidates are required to hold a Master's Degree in Business Management or a related discipline (e.g., Economics). Candidates who have recently completed their Ph.D. may also apply.

<u>Stipend:</u> An all-inclusive monthly emolument in the range of Rs.30,000 (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) to Rs.36,000 (Rupees Thirty-Six Thousand only) per month plus an additional house rent allowance of Rs.8,000 (Rupees Eight Thousand) per month based on educational qualification and experience of the applicant. Annual increment will be based on performance.

<u>Duration of the Assignment</u>: Initially for a period of one year and extendable up to three years based on performance review. If the candidate registers for a Ph.D. programme in another institution within the 3 years, a further extension of two years can be given, and additional one year if sufficient progress on the dissertation work is seen.
