

Background

IIM Bangalore

The Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) is a leading graduate school of management in Asia. The logo of IIMB carries a proclamation in Sanskrit, तेजस्वि नावधीतमस्तु (tejasvi navadhitamastu), which translates to 'let our study be enlightening'. Our vision is to be a global, renowned academic institution fostering excellence in management, innovation, and entrepreneurship for business, government, and society. IIMB has 109 full-time faculty members, along with 11 disciplinary areas and 10 centers of excellence.



Program

The program intends to provide useful inputs to faculty members toward their development as future academic leaders in higher education. IIMB will accommodate 30-40 (As mandated) participants in this program.

Participants and Eligibility

Faculty from centrally-funded institutes, Institutes of National Importance, as well as UGC and AICTE-recognized universities, colleges, and standalone institutes.

Eligibility for Nomination / Selection

The participants must be permanent faculty at recognized institutes with at least 3 years of teaching experience.



Duration



5 days (30 hours) residential program.

Program Fee



INR 50,000/- per participant (inclusive of food and boarding charges for 5 days)


