

Visiting Policy & Management Associateship 2021-22

The Center for Public Policy, IIM Bangalore is inviting proposals from PGPPM alumni for the Visiting Policy & Management Associates program. This program allows PGPPM alumni to visit IIMB to prepare a quality paper for the Occasional Paper Series of the Center and a teaching case (with possible supervision and co-authorship from an IIMB Faculty) that either builds on their dissertation/policy memo or can be on a new topic.

Proposals must be sent in the attached format and may be developed with prior consultation with an IIMB faculty. Candidates for Visiting Policy & Management Associates in 2021-22 will be selected on the basis of a review by an academic screening committee at the Center for Public Policy. The invited alumni will be invited to the campus for a period up to a month. The goal is to ensure that dedicated time is available to convert the proposal into a publishable paper and a teaching case. The paper will be reviewed and brought out as a Centre for Public Policy Occasional Paper.

Centre for Public Policy will pay an amount upto Rs.20,000/- to meet travel expenses against submission of bills. Accommodation facility in campus (on availability) and an amount of Rs.25,000/-towards board and miscellaneous expenses will be made available during the stay at IIMB. Stays shorter than a month will be pro-rated.
